

Interior and exterior perimeter sprays are common as preventative sprays to keep insects and spiders out of living areas. Following the guidelines below will allow us to provide the best possible service and our guarantee.

Before Treatment

- All people and pets should be out of the treatment area. Fish tanks must be unplugged and covered.
- Move furniture and items away from room corners.*
- Put all food, drinks, and food prep items (pots, pans, etc) away.*
- □ Close all windows.
- □ Make sure the technician has access to all areas to be treated.
- Everything against or near the house should be moved at least 3' away from the foundation.
- □ Clean up debris around the foundation of the home.
- □ Cover edible plants (or we can spray around them).
- If an outside treatment is planned, some overspray onto windows is typical. Plan accordingly by waiting until after the treatment to wash the windows.

Following Treatment

- □ Keep people and pets out of outside treated areas until dry. Dry times will vary depending on temperature, humidity, and other variables.
- □ The home may be entered two hours after being treated.*
- Ventilate all rooms by opening windows.*
- □ Thoroughly wash all table and counter-tops.*
- Avoid exposing outside treated areas to abnormal amounts of water, such as via powerwashing siding and eaves, as this may prematurely wash off any chemicals applied.
 Washing windows with conservative amounts of Windex (or equivalent) is fine.
- Fix any problematic areas mentioned by the technician that could lead to insects making it past the barrier.
 - * only necessary if treating inside the home
